Use this kit to set up a stand in your neighborhood. Afterwards, you can decide if you want the money raised to go to Shepherd's Gate Shelter or to Ukrainian refugees in Germany.

- Lemonade Mix and Cups - to provide refreshing drinks
- Poster Board - to advertise your stand
- White Bag - to decorate and collect donations
- Envelope - to turn the donations into the office. Write on the envelope which charity you want to receive the donations. Money can be turned in to the school office by August 26th.

And be sure to use the devotion on the other side to learn about helping those in need.

1. Who were the different people in the story and how did they respond to the man that was hurt?
2. Why does Jesus want us to be like the Good Samaritan?
3. What does it mean to you to be a good neighbor?
4. When can it be hard to be a good neighbor?
5. Who are some of the people in the world that could use your help?
6. Who is one person you can care for this week?
